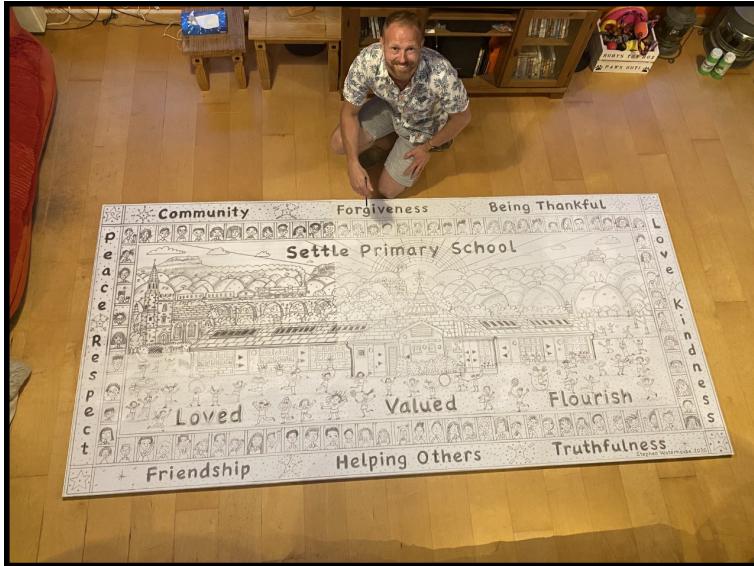


Lara the Cow Gets a Makeover!
