



Reading Reward Systems (Year 1 – 5)

Around the World Reading Expedition - New Reading Reward Scheme September 2018



There are a total of 5 'Reading Passports':

- 1 **Europe**
- 2 **America**
- 3 **Africa**
- 4 **Asia**
- 5 **Oceania**

Each passport is made up of 20 capital cities from a range of countries. The children can be rewarded a 'Book mile' sticker for reading regularly at home, exceptional reading in guided reading sessions, or maybe moving onto the next colour band – the reasons can be at teacher discretion - 'Book Miles' are not just for every book read though (otherwise they would complete the passport too soon!).

Each city/page in the passport has 10 book mile sticker circles to fill in and collect. Passports will be kept in the classroom in a box/basket so that they stay at school. Each time a child collects 10 stickers in their passport they are rewarded that country's flag from the teacher (see Passport Folders for stickers).



When a child completes their passport, they will receive a special certificate presented to them in Praise Assembly. They can then take their passport home to keep.



There is a central world map display (in the hall) with all the countries located on a large world map so children can see where they can travel to.

Teachers check reading record books each week and award 'Book Miles' as an exciting incentive for children to read at home.

When all 5 passports have been completed children will receive the 'World Traveller' certificate in recognition of all their reading.





Reading Reward Systems (Year 6)

Starbooks Rewards



Books in the Year 6 'Starbooks' area are categorized into 3 groups.

There are 3 levels

Bronze: Read 3 bronze books and 3 of your own choice.

Silver: Read 4 silver books and 4 of your own choice.

Gold: Read 5 gold books and 5 of your own choice.

Excellence Award: For children who continually challenge themselves (unlimited amount of rewards for this).

When a child completes each level, they will receive a certificate presented to them in Praise Assembly.

Children can enjoy a hot chocolate in a Starbucks cup for every award!

Reading record books are checked each week.
