School Assessment

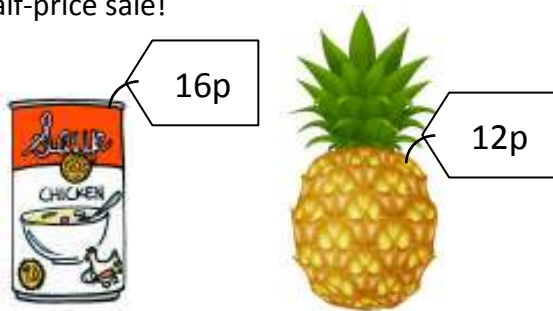
Your child will be tested 3 times throughout the half-term.
